Monocyte Chemotactic Protein-5/CCL12 (MCP-5/CCL12) (Murine)

Description:

Monocyte Chemotactic Protein (MCP proteins belong to the CC chemokine family, and signal through CCR2 and, with the exception of MCP-1, other CCR receptors. The MCP proteins chemoattract and activate monocytes, activated T cells, basophils, NK cells, and immature dendritic cells. The MCP family cross- reacts across species.

Source:

Escherichia coli

Reconstitution:

We recommend that this vial be briefly centrifuged prior to opening to bring the contents to the bottom. Reconstitute in sterile distilled water or aqueous buffer containing 0.1% BSA to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/mL. Stock solutions should be apportioned into working aliquots and stored at < -20°C. Further dilutions should be made in appropriate buffered solutions.

Formulation:

Lyophilized from a 0.2 µm filtered concentrated solution in PBS, pH 7.4.

Storage:

This lyophilized preparation is stable at 2-8°C, but should be kept at -20°C for long term storage, preferably desiccated. Upon reconstitution, the preparation is stable for up to one week at 2-8°C. For maximal stability, apportion the reconstituted preparation into working aliquots and store at -20°C to -70°C. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.

Molecular Weight:

Approximately 9.3 kDa, a single non-glycosylated polypeptide chain containing 82 amino acids.

Endotoxin:

Less than 1 EU/ μ g of MCP-5/CCL12 as determined by LAL method.

Usage:

Biological Activity:

The biologically active determined by a chemotaxis bioassay using human peripheral blood monocytes is in a concentration range of 10-50 ng/mL.

Sterile filtered white lyophilized (freeze-dried) powder.
